

APPLICATION HINTS:

Apply to the drip zone of the plant and lightly work into the soil surface or cover with an organic mulch. Be careful not to damage fine shallow surface roots as this renders them prone to fungal attack and fertiliser burn. Apply sparingly on potted plants as excessive fertiliser can cause burning relatively easily. It is much safer to apply small amounts on a regular basis.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- Always water fertiliser well immediately after application. Watering should result in a thorough saturation of the area
- Avoid direct contact with plant roots, seeds etc
- Even, light and regular applications of this quality product will achieve the best results
- Always reseal bags after use and dispose of empty containers properly
- Sandy soils will require lower rates of fertiliser but more frequent applications
- Do not exceed the recommended application rates as this can be harmful to plants.

CAUTION: All fertilisers should be used with care. Wear gloves and protect eyes from splashing.

HOW MUCH DO YOU NEED:

Rhododendrons

YOUNG PLANTS: Apply 25-50 grams per square metre, 3 or 4 times a year. Feeding during the months of August, October, December and March will provide best results.

ESTABLISHED SHRUBS: Apply 50-75 grams per square metre, 3 or 4 times a year. Feeding during the months of August, October, December and March will provide best results. In sandy soils use less (approximately half) the application rates as advised above but feed more regularly. This will prevent excess nutrients leaching into the environment and provide *more nutrient to the plant.*
